- Creating effective diagrams and pictures; and,
- How to utilize these tools for effective advocacy.

It is hoped that by the end of the course participants will know how to create dynamic, yet simple presentations that will support your organizations advocacy efforts. This course is aimed at anyone and you do not require any particular expertise to attend. The course will include a small workshop where, together, we can work on issues and ideas from your organization that you would like to present or display in a visual way. You are encouraged to send through any issues or ideas you may have in advance of the workshop so that we can mould the course to your specific requirements.
